6 Queens Road, Aberdeen

No.6 Queens Road in Aberdeen's west end was originally a substantial granite built dwelling house, given over to offices some years ago. AC Yule were asked by Architects Fitzgerald Associates to advise on glazing options for a large office extension on 3 floors to the rear of the existing premises.

The Client/Developers brief called for large expanses of structurally glazed non-opening façade panels. The top floor of the extension was set back from the main building footprint to provide a balcony terrace to which a freestanding glass balustrade was included.

AC Yule's preferred solution to the façade panels was to use spider fittings attached to stainless steel clamps all in a mirror finish. The spiders were bolted back to glass fins which were exposed within the office space giving a modern contemporary feel to the new prominent office building.

The building has since been occupied by Space Solutions and has attained a civic award for its architects.
